Hall-Irwin Corporation is set to begin construction on the expansion in April 2019 with an expected opening date in the Summer of 2020. The expansion will include a community/party room, outdoor lap pool with waterslide and basketball hoops, hot tub and an outdoor party space.

With the added space and amenities TRPR is excited to be able to offer swim lessons, a swim team, water based exercise classes, expanded pool party options, and more community events.
